NOTE: Pre-employment controlled substance test results are subject to review. These records may be kept separately from the general driver files if the district / carrier elects to do so.

NOTE: Effective July 1st, 2010, a school activity / MFSAB was changed to allow a 14,500 lbs. gross vehicle weight rating / 15 passengers or less to be operated in Minnesota with a valid class D (passenger vehicle) license. (M.S. 171.02 sub 2a).
