2. Is dyslexia because of low intelligence?

Dyslexia affects students across a range of cognitive abilities.

3. Should I wait to see if my child's reading improves on its own?

Struggling students need intervention, and early intervention is more effective than later intervention.





4. Isn't seeing letters backwards a dyslexia thing??

It's common for all developmentally, young readers to reverse letters or misrecognize similarly spelled words.

5. Do students with dyslexia need special fonts?

Special dyslexia fonts have not been shown to result in improved reading accuracy or rate.





6. Do colored overlays alleviate dyslexia?

While vision problems may interfere with learning, they are not the primary cause of dyslexia, so vision treatments do not target causes of dyslexia.
